It was our one opportunity to be “off stage” and interact with our growing extended family with multiple memories of raising our children, our blessings, along with challenges, hardships to overcome none of us could count. **Yet we were all together at the table** to celebrate the most beautiful aroma institution of marriage.

That is the same priority with couples getting married **each Friday in our court halls.** The honor of praying over them in their new journey of oneness in marriage is my highlight.

Yet on the lefthand side, **our judges also face the job of unresolved or broken relationships ending in divorce.** It is the most difficult decision they face when nothing can be resolved. I’m not sure how judges handle irreconcilable marriage collisions, but there is one hidden core principle missing that cuts to the heart of marriages. **FORGIVEN TO FORGIVE** **Our weekly prayer for our judges is by name so extremely valuable** as they seek creative ways to resolve descension, revenge, unforgiveness, jealousy, or just fed-up.

All of life is about harmonizing relationships in the most difficult unexpected collusions and complexity of family interactions. They should strengthen and bond what was so weak or fragile.

A starting block is recognition of what they already have. If there is food in your fridge, clothes on your body, a roof over your head, and a bed to sleep in you are richer than 75% of the world. If you have some money and freedom to move you're already in the top 18%. If your body is healthy today you're more fortunate than 1,000,000 people who won't survive this week. If you can read this and see this, understand this you are more fortunate than 3 billion people who cannot. Pause, breathe, be thankful you're already living someone else's prayer. The life we often complain about is the life someone else is praying for right now.

Laugh together. Make sacrifices. Add date night. Say I love you daily. Give other space. Always kiss goodnight. Communicate feelings. **Always forgive because you have been forgiven by God Himself.** Make time for one another. Always have each other's back. Learn each other's blood language. Listen. Set goals together. Don't compare. Their relationships are spontaneous. Don't raise their voices. Give thoughtful surprises. Don't get others involved in conflicts. Work through their problems by checking in throughout the day. Make time for intimacy.
